## **FISHING REPORT - SEPTEMBER 2009**

After a flurry of activity out wide during August on Blues, Stripes and Yellowfin Tuna, mainly encountered by *Saltshaker*, September was disappointing. A number of boats eagerly took advantage of the good weather, only to return fishless!

InDeep landed its largest YFT, shown at right.

The reports from up north are that the first year class of Black Marlin appears to be non-existent (raising concerns as to the future of our Black Marlin season), although the big Black Marlin season appears to be off to a good start.



Amberjack, Yellowtail Kingfish and Samson Fish have generally been on the chew on the deeper reefs. However, Snapper and Pearl Perch have continued to be a hit and miss affair, with them biting strongly on some days and not on other days. The Teraglin have generally been more consistent.

Jon Norling and Lenny Moody had a terrific trip up in the NT during the month waving the fly rods around. Come along to the October meeting for a full update or wait for the article to appear in next month's Newsletter.
